Applications for the EMS Bridge program are accepted on a continual basis for fall, spring and summer. Applicants must possess an active and valid North Carolina EMT-Paramedic or National Registry EMT-Paramedic credential to be accepted into the program. In addition, the student must possess a current basic cardiac life support certification, current advanced cardiac life support certification, current basic trauma life support certification and current pediatric advanced life support certification.

Graduation

The EMS Bridge associate degree is awarded upon successful completion of all required coursework prescribed in the program of study. Students must earn a C or better in all EMS and BIO coursework. Crosswalk credit will not be awarded until after successful completion of the EMS curriculum courses.
